The Directors of The Muslim Jewish Forum of Greater Manchester present their annual report together with the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2025.

Our purpose

The objects for which the Forum is established are to develop the cultural and social ties between the Muslim and Jewish Communities of Greater Manchester; to educate members of the Muslim and Jewish Communities in relation to their shared values and common Abrahamic tradition, heritage, history and culture; maximising their potential and improving their health and well-being as residents of Greater Manchester; and to promote better understanding within the wider community of the interests and values that are common to the Muslim and Jewish Communities.

During the year, the Forum has held a number of events to further these objects:

7 June 2024 — Five members of the Executive visited Oslo, where amongst other places they visited the Jewish Museum and the largest mosque in Norway, the Central Jamaat-e Ahl-e Sunnat Mosque.

23 June 2024 — Robert Kanter delivered a Zoom presentation on "The Salman Rushdie / Satanic Verses affair and Muslim Jewish relations."

28 July 2024 — Annual picnic in St Mary's Park Prestwich, which was attended by 25 people.

3 November 2024 — Visit to Holocaust Centre North in Huddersfield. 14 people from Manchester, Sheffield, and London took part in this visit.

24 November 2024 — "Loose Lawyers" panel event at Salford Civic Centre in Swinton attended by 32 people. The topic was "Which Jewish or Islamic religious laws would England benefit from incorporating in her laws?"

9 March 2025 — Annual iftar held at Salford Civic Centre in Swinton and attended by 53 people.

The Forum also supported other organisations' events. Some of these are listed below:

10 August 2024 — Forum Co-Chair Cllr Heather Fletcher spoke at the Azeemia Foundation's 22nd Adam Day commemoration event.

14 September 2024 — Forum Co-Chair Cllr Heather Fletcher spoke at an interfaith event in Manchester: "The Relevance of Faith in an Increasingly Secular Society."

Financial accounts

The financial accounts, which comprise an Income and Expenditure Account and a Balance Sheet, are set out on the following pages. Due to the small size of the company's turnover and assets, the accounts are not required to be audited.

During the year, the Forum had total receipts of £495.00 and total expenditures of £1,090.75 resulting in an overall deficit of £595.75 as detailed in the Income and Expenditure account. The overall financial position is considered satisfactory due to the Forum's reserves and the relatively small amounts involved..

Charitable status

The Forum is registered as a charity with HM Revenue & Customs with effect from 9 May 2014. Accordingly, donors to the Forum who are taxpayers are requested to complete a gift aid declaration which can be downloaded from the "Join us" section of our website. Donors to the Forum who are

higher rate taxpayers should be able to claim higher rate tax relief through self-assessment for their donations.
